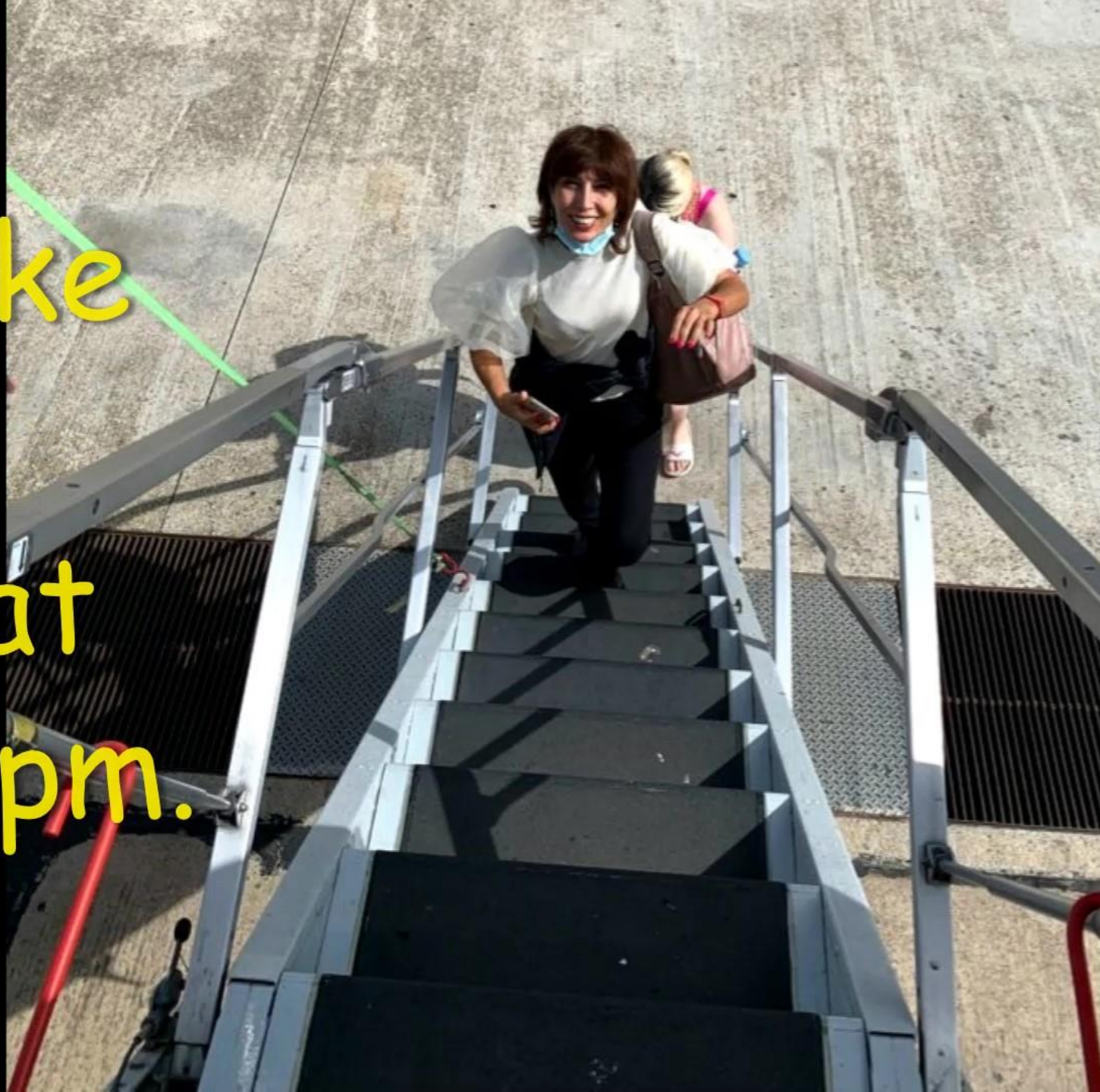

The flight lasts 3 hours but ends soon thanks to my reading on Dublin.

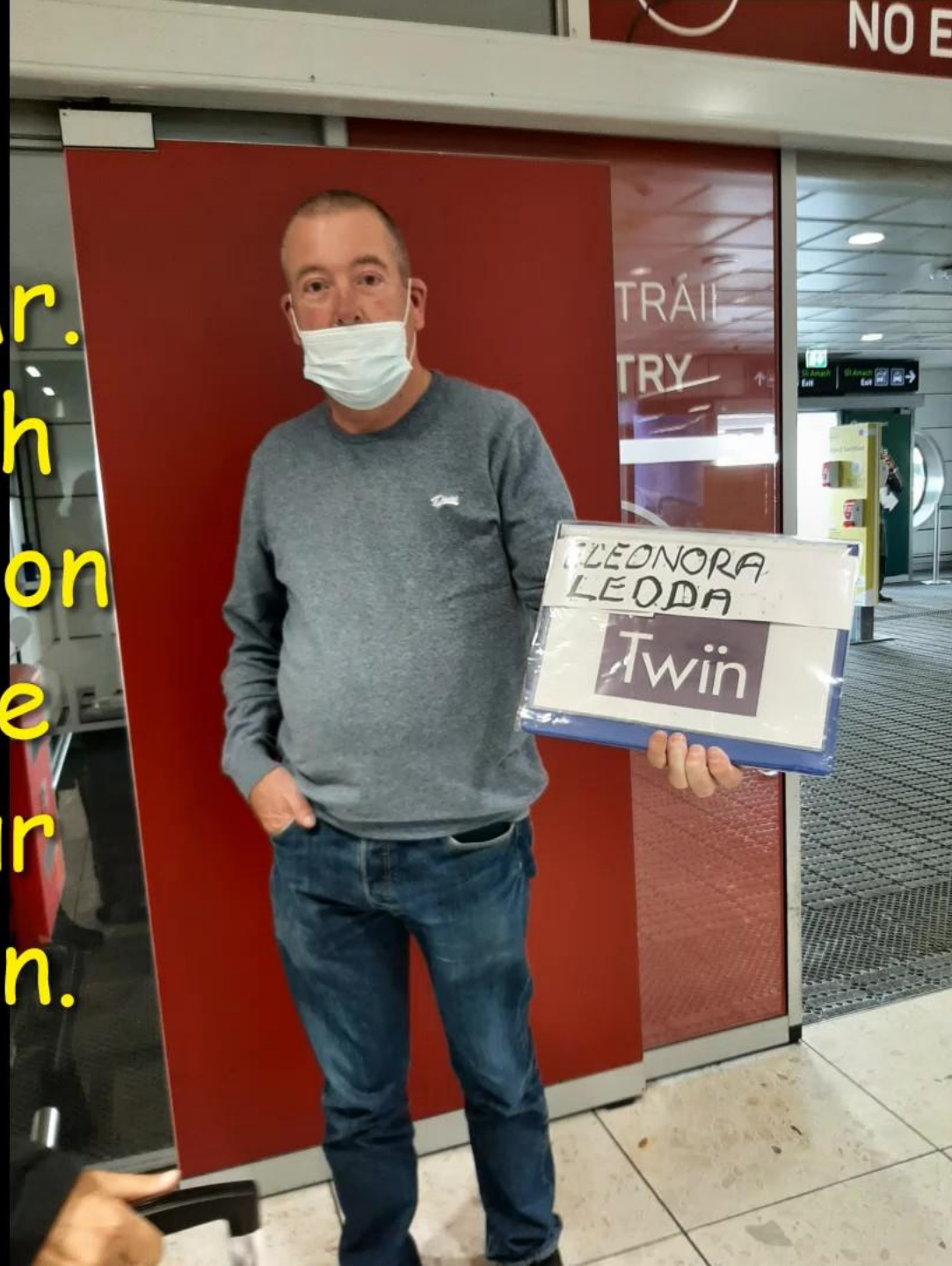

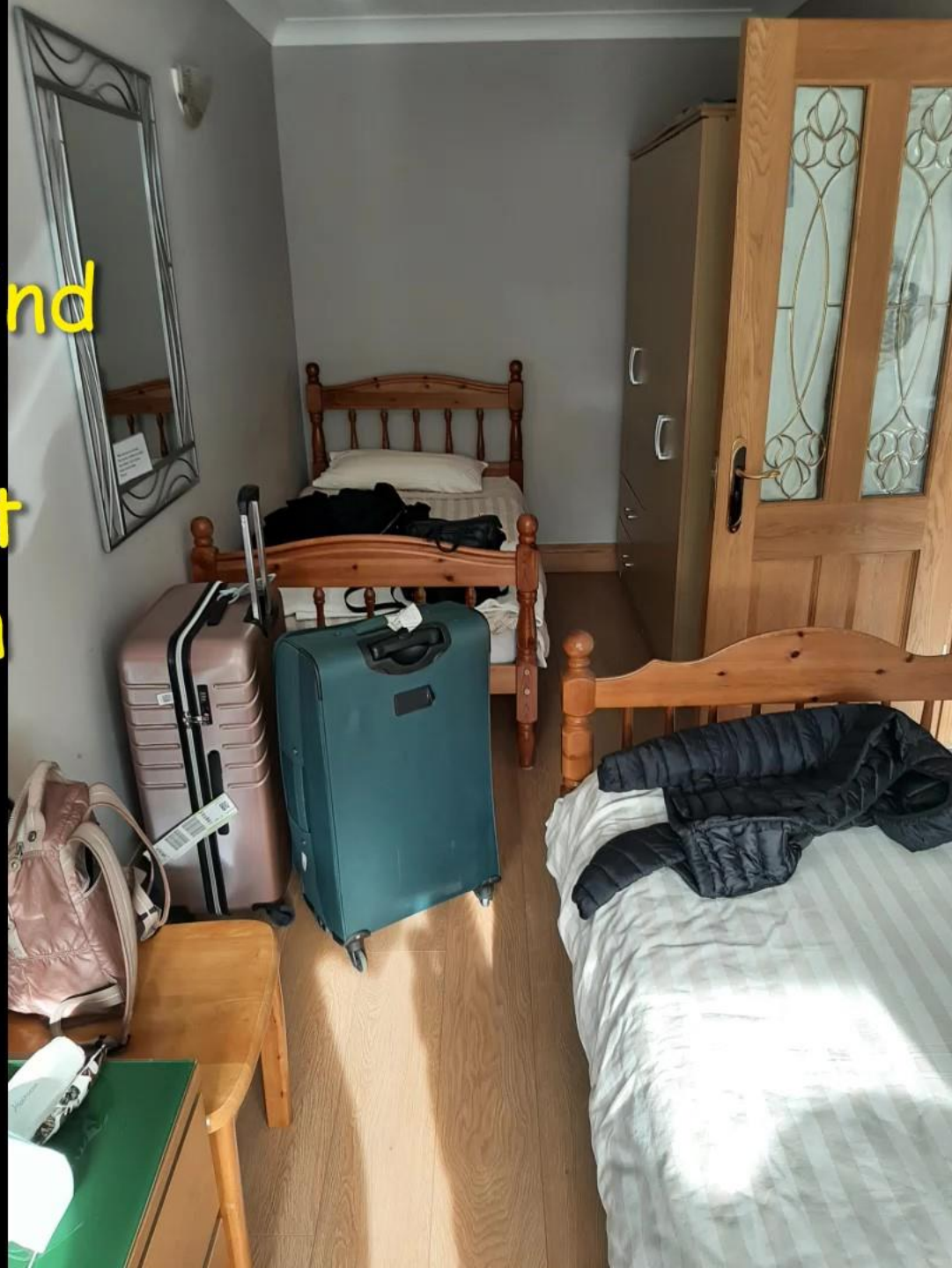
On arrival Mr. Joe Cavanagh will take us, on behalf of the school, to our accomodation.



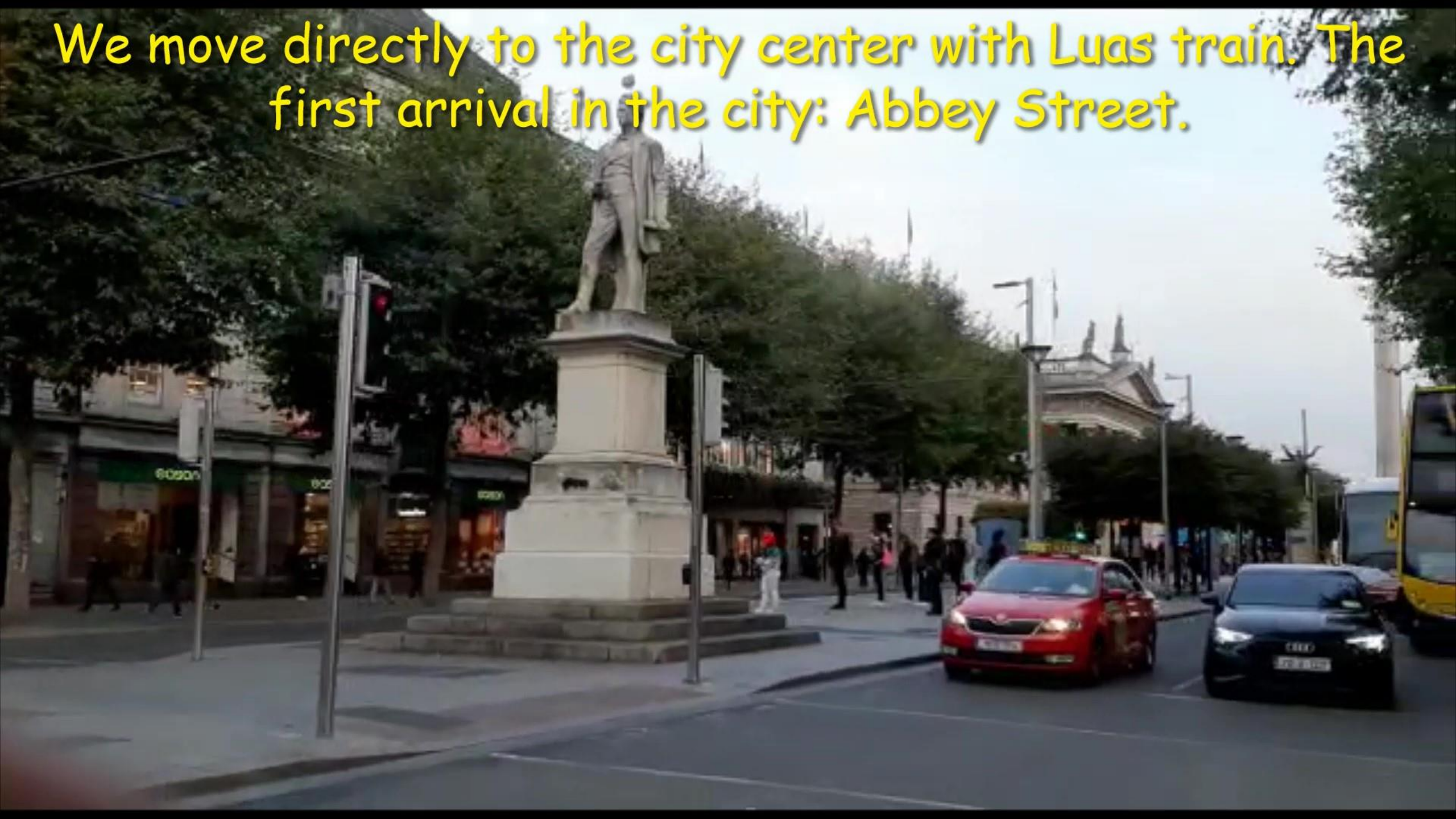
It is not the size of the room to leave us puzzled, but the fact that there's no desk neither chairs.



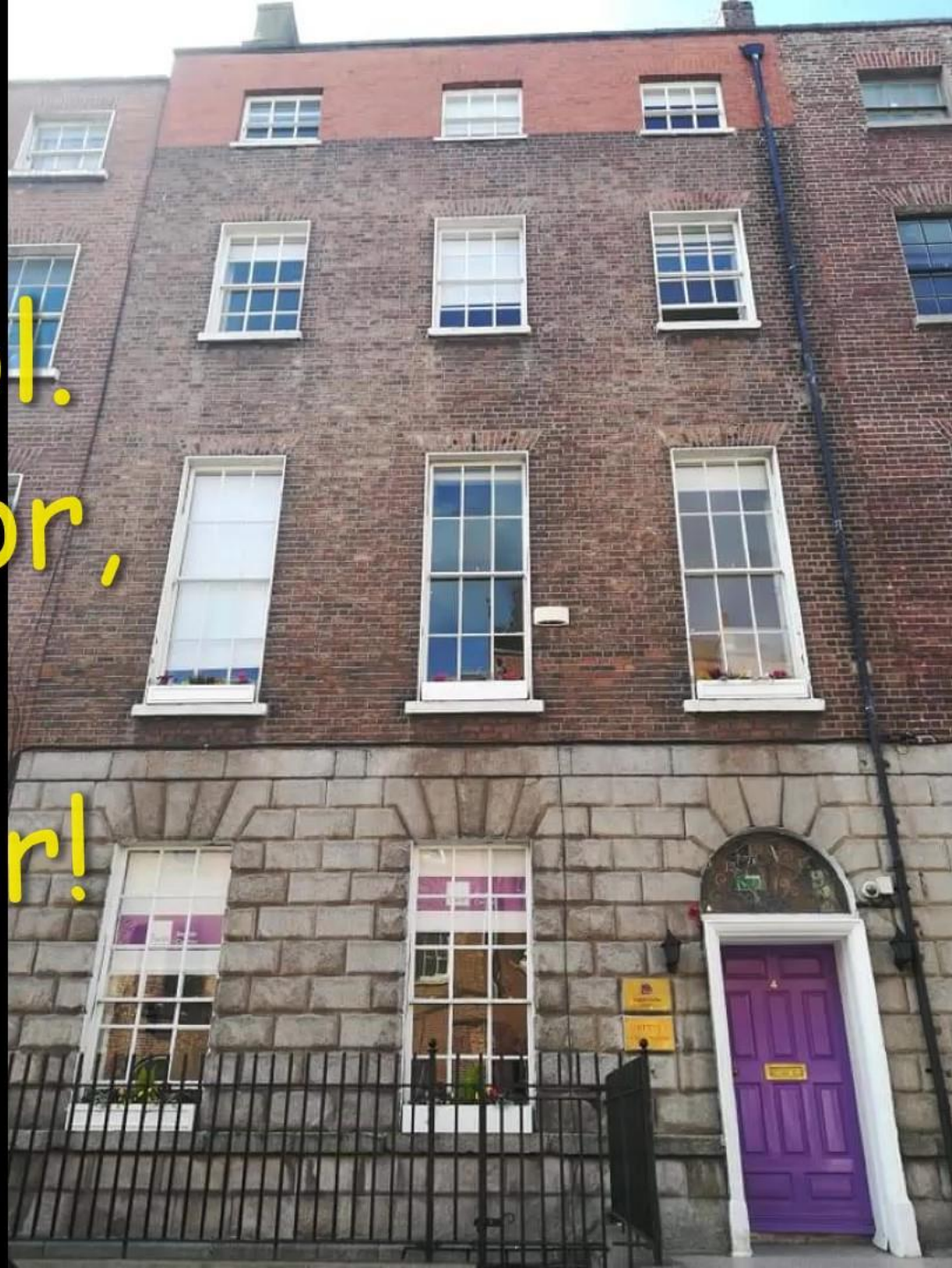
Moreover we find out that the bathroom is not reserved but in common with other three people.

pubs.

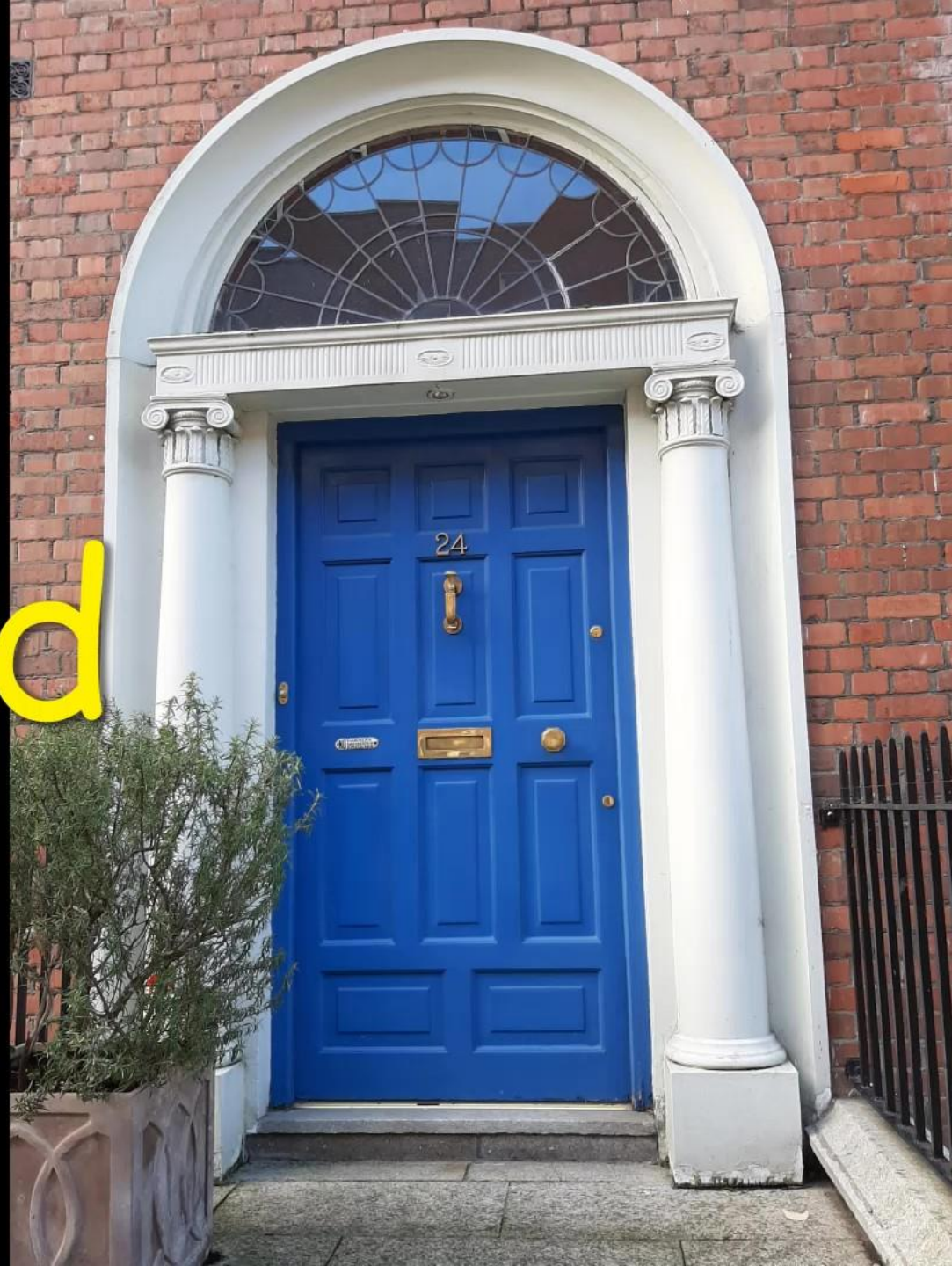
